The Young Choir Paderborn (Junge Kantorei Paderborn) formed itself as a project-related ensemble in the first few years after the founding of the Mädchenkantorei. The design of festive services in the Paderborn Cathedral as well as outstanding concert projects (Mozart: Requiem · Brahms: A German Requiem · Bach: Matthew Passion) are in center of the project work.

The first concert tour of this choir formation took place in Poland in 2018. Since then it has appeared successfully again and again. In 2023, special highlights will be the performance of Joseph Haydn's „The Creation“ with the baroque orchestra „Echo di Rheno“ and a concert tour to the USA, which will lead via New York to the main destination, Atlanta.
